 - Late in the whole process
 - Too late for field work

- Two parts
 - Housing Units
 - February 2010
 - Before Census
 - Group Quarters
 - Augustus 2010
 - After Census


Housing Units - Objective

- Find major omissions and miss-allocations
 - Apartment building
 - Off the road community
 - New development
- Threshold initially set at 50 units to file an issue

Housing Units – State data

- Address (City style OR non-city style)
- Lat/Long
- Number of units at this address

Differences with LUCA

- Before/after canvassing
- Include non-city style addresses
- Focus on major discrepancies
- Less depending on geo-coding (address to lat/long)
 - Avoiding TIGER issues

Housing Units – Data Sources

- Real Property data
- Alternative:
 - E911 data
 - Difficult to acquire
 - InfoUSA
 - Quality and price unknown at this moment
 - Local data??
- No address matching

Real Property Challenges

- Not always electronic shape files
- Lat/Long in the file is not always in NY
- A parcel is not a lat/long
- No zip codes
- No number of units


Group Quarters - Objective

- Find missed / miss-allocated Group Quarters
 - Focus on larger Group Quarters
 - Mainly Correctional, Nursing homes, Dormitories, Military barracks

- Lat/Long
- Expected count (if available)

- We already have a mostly complete list of mentioned GQs
- Manual verification
 - Dedicated web application
 - Phone calls
